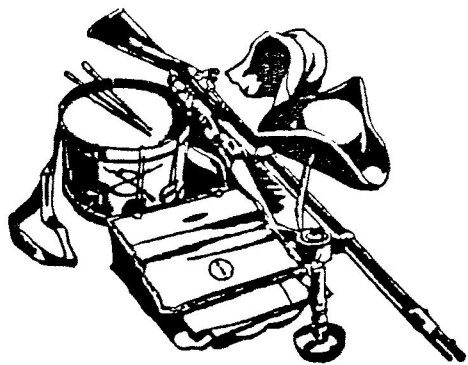

ANDREW HOPPER
CONTEMPORARY OF GEORGE WASHINGTON

On February 25, 1987 members of the GSRC and their guests are invited to the home of members Joan & Tom Dater. This meeting is especially appropriate for the birthday month of our first president, since the Daters' ancestor, Andrew Hopper, was well acquainted with George Washington.

Andrew Hopper's house, reportedly once stood on what is now Valley Rd in Mahwah, N.J. (The house no longer exists.) This house was used as a headquarters by Washington in 1777, 1780, and 1781.

In addition to serving as a host to the future first president of the United States, some sources maintain that Hopper was employed by Washington as a spy for the patriot cause. An article published in "The Call" magazine, dated 17 February 1968 cites writing by a Benson J. Lossing, dated 1852 which asserts that "(Hopper) was often employed by Washington in the Secret Service, and frequently visited his friends in New York City while the enemy had possession of it...."

Unfortunately, Mr. Lossing did not cite sources for this information, and according to the article, modern historians have been unable to prove this claim.

Andrew Hopper was born in 1746, and died in 1813. He married Maria LaRue. They had only one child, Anna, baptized 9 October, 1774 in the Dutch Reformed Church in Paramus.

He served as a freeholder in Bergen Co. from 1780 to 1782. He is mentioned by name only once in the writings of George Washington. Some researchers believe that the omission of his name from Washington's notes may have been deliberate, to protect his identity.

Hopper is reportedly buried in a family cemetery not far from the site of his home.

Mr. and Mrs. Dater plan to display and describe some of their Washington memorabilia at our February meeting. Plan to attend this unusual program.

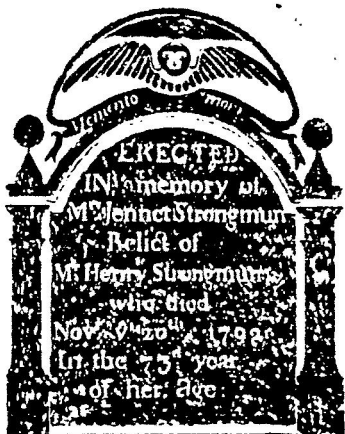

and the indexes were compiled by Marie Koestler.

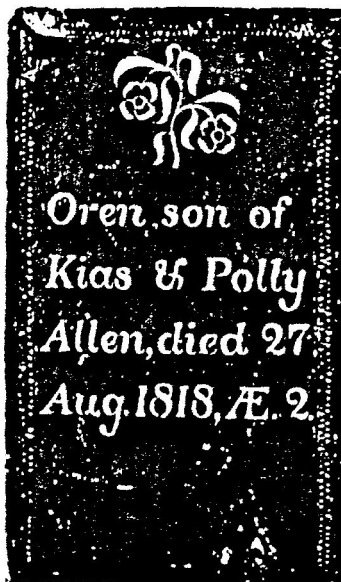
The notices are on file in the Historical

Charlotte Burrow.

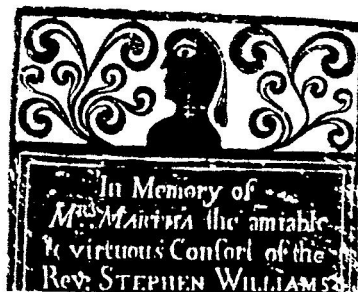
