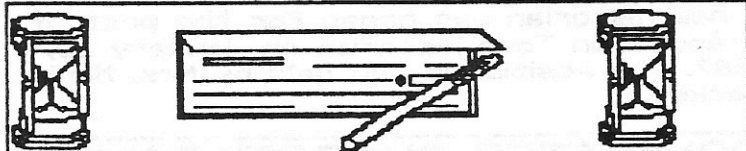
## PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

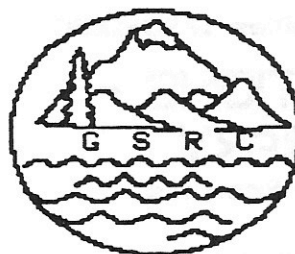

sailing. The search costs \$30. For visitors,

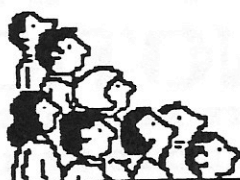
the process takes only an hour. By mail,

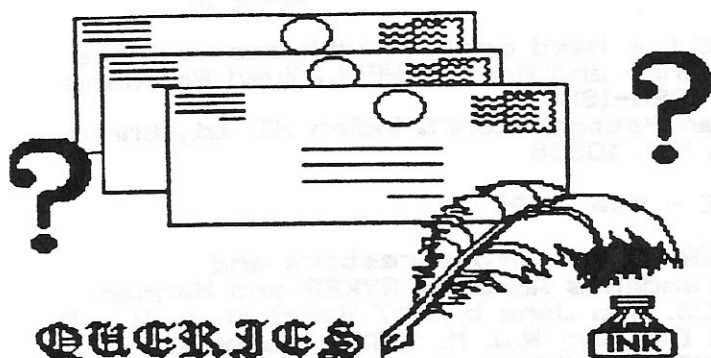

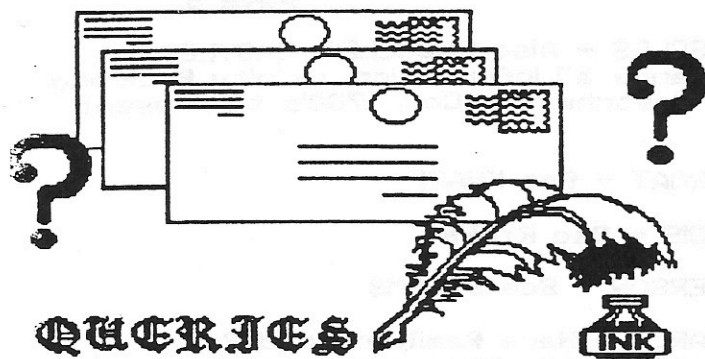
