



Orange Co. Militia in the American Revolution

Program Presented at the Sept. 23, 2008, Meeting of the Genealogical Society of Rockland County

Synopsis of the program and the handout prepared by Sally Pellegrini, New City Library: Sources: Budke, G.H. 1976. Rockland County During the American Revolution, 1776-1781, New City, NY: Rockland County Public Librarians Assoc. Rasnick, Marvin. "Staunch Patriot: Ann Hawkes Hay," South of the Mountain, vol. 23, no. 4 (Oct-Dec 1979) 7-8, 12-13.

Two regiments of militia were formed in Orange County South of the Mountains Haverstraw Precinct; one under the command of Col. Abraham Lent (22 Dec 1775), one under Col. Ann Hawkes Hay (16 Feb 1776.). The regiments were consolidated under Col. Hay on 28 May 1778. He had served from 1777-1778, 1781, and resigned 01 Jan 1783.

The Haverstraw regiments, or lower Orange (south side) area were headquartered at Orange-Town.

Chronology of Service

1777

<u>September</u>: The Militia guarded the west shore of the Hudson River including Clarkstown, Kakiat, Short Clove and Long Clove.

1778

<u>January-April</u>: Watched the west shore of the Hudson River.

<u>May:</u> Guarded the south end of Orange County, cutting off supplies going to the British in New York City. Scouting patrols were routinely dispatched from Smith Clove into New Jersey to keep an eye on the British posts at Paulus Hook (Jersey City).

<u>June-October</u>: Watched from Sneden's Ferry to Kings Ferry (Stony Point); headquartered in Clarkstown.

<u>September:</u> Followed British troops that had attacked (massacred) a portion of the Continental Army; Col. George Baylor's Dragoons bivouacked in six barns and out-buildings along Overkill Road (now River Vale Road).

1779

<u>February</u>: Detachment at Kings Ferry (Stony Point) to work on the blockhouse, redoubt, palisades, and barbette. Trees were cut for a field of fire to surround the defensive works.

NOTE: A barbette is a platform or mound within a fort to permit firing over the parapet.

March: Muster roll was 459 and in June – 429 men.

July: A detachment sent to the Battle of Minisink was defeated.

October: Estimated only 300 men on the muster roll.

1780

<u>April</u>: Troops were raised from Orange and Ulster Counties for the defense of the counties; they rendezvoused at Nyack.

August: 100 men on the muster roll at Tappan.

October: Men were assigned to Soldier's Fortune on the rocky crest west of West Point.

<u>December</u>: Levies were detached for service in the Continental Army

NOTE: Levies - men recruited by the 1st, 3rd, and 5th New York Continental Line Regiments to make up the short-fall of soldiers. The Levies were usually in service for less than the duration of the war.

Non-commissioned officers and privates got a bounty of twenty dollars. Land grants to Line officers and soldiers: a captain -300 acres; a lieutenant -200 acres; ensigns -150 acres; each non-commissioned soldier -100 acres for their Continental service.

1781

February: General Washington directed the men to be ready to assemble the regiment in Haverstraw and send a detachment to the pass at the entrance to the Clove, near Suffern, and to other mountain passes.


<u>March</u>: Troops were garrisoned at the block house at Sneden's Landing.

Bullet Mold



Bullet Mold – this little appliance would have been found in any colonial Rocklander's kit bag. It was filled with molten lead, allowed to cool, and then the lead ball was tapped out of the mold and finished by "nipping" of the tail of lead that was the last drip of liquid metal in the pour hole of the mold. The tail was usually saved and added to the next batch. This mold belongs to K. Lamberton of Suffern, NY.

Rockland Scrapbook - I have received an old recipe that is at least 4 generations old in one of our member's families; photos of several towns in Rockland county prior to 1900; a photo of a member's great grandmother's tea cup which illustrates what kind of designs were popular around the mid-1800s; and other goodies not to be divulged yet! 





Your request will not need to go on the bottom of a pile which may reach the top a year or more later and no one will have to go trough the records searching for the name(s). You are just providing information that you obtained from the Albany NYS Archives. Please see form and Instructions on pages 29 and 30.



FROM OUR MEMBERS

Dear GSRC Editor,

I read the President's Message in the September 2008 Newsletter about brick walls. My brick wall is for my ancestor Jacob Conklin b.1763 in Orange County, probably in the area that is now Rockland County. I have sent this same Bible record to the Orange County Genealogical Society for their Newsletter.

This Jacob Conklin Bible information was printed in two issues of the DAR Magazine (I do not have the Bible). I have printed the bible record exactly as it was printed in the DAR magazines, but I have discovered some corrections in my research of the family.

I have shared the detailed information of my Jacob Conklin line with descendants of the Armstrong family who have posted the details on-line, so this Jacob Conklin information is available when searching WorldConnect for example.

My Brick Wall is the location of Jacob Conklin b.1790 in Orange (Rockland) County prior to 1820 when Jacob Conklin and father James and brother James (Jr) b.1800 moved to Owego, Tioga, NY. Jacob married Joanna (AKA Johanna) Armstrong, from Florida, Orange, NY, on Sept 10, 1814 - location unknown. James and his sons were all wagon makers - residence unknown. I believe that James (Sr) had other children between 1790 and 1800 who remained in Orange County after 1820. I am hoping the publishing this Jacob Conklin Bible record in your next wsletter might help other Conklin researchers with their brick wall, and might help me with mine.

This CONKLIN Family Bible information, has been printed in the DAR Magazines in December 1984, pages 786-788 and March 2000, pages 174-180. DAR Magazine has said that they do not know who submitted this information.

MEMORIAL REMEMBRANCE TO LETCHWORTH RESIDENTS BURIED ANONYMOUSLY

A Bronze Memorial plaque was placed at the Old Letchworth Village Cemetery, Call Hollow Road, Thiells in August. The State plans to hold a memorial dedication in the spring of 2009. After many months of searching the records for names to go with the 910 small T-shaped metal markers with numbers, Jacqueline Ferrara, ombudsman for the Hudson Valley Developmental Disabilities Services Office, has succeeded. The names that go with the numbers are listed on the plaque in rows in the order of the deaths of these former Letchworth residents.

"Those Who Shall Not Be Forgotten" is written on the plaque in an attempt to atone for the past wrongs. In addition to the names of those buried from December of 1917 through 1967, there are six former residents buried on Cheesecote Mountain in Haverstraw from 1914 to 1917. The site is unknown and unmarked.

Senator Thomas Morahan introduced the legislation that allows the OMRDD to release the names and dates of birth and death of any patient who lived in one of the states facilities for the purpose of inscribing a headstone.

People with developmental disabilities and mental illnesses, orphans, the homeless and those deemed unmanageable were sent to Letchworth during most of the 20th century. In many cases, parents hid the fact that they had a child with disabilities; they did not let other members of the family know about the child. They were told to bring them to Letchworth and forget about them.

Thanks to Miss Ferrara, the 910 people buried at the old cemetery at Letchworth are now remembered by name. The Dater Mansion once stood at the strip that houses Krauser's and adjacent stores on East Main Street.

The book gives insights into how Ramsey residents went about their daily loves and what expectations they had for each other. It sheds light on a time when elegance and grace were the order of the day. How local residents conducted themselves has much to say to our current, local culture.



- No information shall be released from a record unless the person to whom the record relates is known to the applicant to be deceased.
- No information shall be released unless the record has been on file for a minimum required period: birth records
 must have been on file for at least 75 years, death records for 50 years, marriage records for 50 years (both parties
 to the marriage must be deceased).
- The time periods above are waived if the applicant is a descendant and provides documentation of direct line descent. A party acting on behalf of a descendant shall further provide documentation that the descendant authorized the party to make such application.

Completing the Form

- If you are using Adobe Reader 5.0 or newer (available as a free download from www.adobe.com) you can fill in the form directly in Adobe Reader by clicking on the appropriate space and entering the information (use the TAB key to move to the next field, shift-TAB to move backwards).
