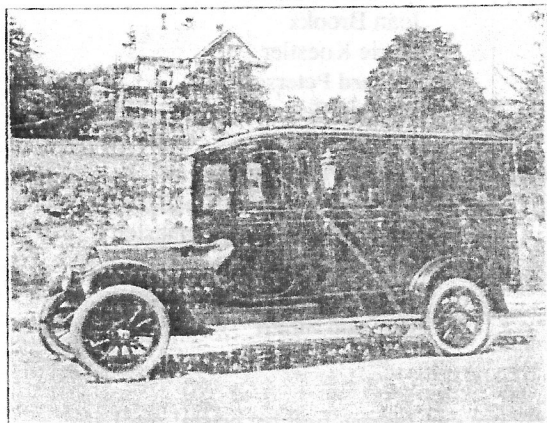

Clarkstown Posts Historical Data Documents Dating to 18th Century Put Online for All to See

In 1785, Clarkstown ordered the building of a poorhouse on court property to provide shelter for the indigent. Local resident Jacob Cole was allotted a sum of 150 pounds to build and supervise the poorhouse.

The yellowing, brittle paper that records one of the town's first acts of social service has been sitting with thousands of similar historical documents in fireproof safes in a vault behind Town Clerk David Carlucci's office. Now, for the first time, these documents are also available on the town's Web site for all residents and history buffs to read.

"These records...are old and rare," said Carlucci. "I believe that the more sets of eyes we have on the documents, the more we'll be able to uncover history that has been lost to the ages." The documents can be seen at www.town.clarkstown.ny.us/html/town_clerk_historical_records.html.

Once the process is completed, residents can view a variety of documents going back to 1752, including minutes from the "precinct of Haverstraw," which included a large swath of Rockland, including modern day Clarkstown.

Available online is an April 7, 1752 resolution that calls for keeping records of all land deeds, earmarks, public highways and branding of animals. Samuel Coe, the document records, was elected clerk for the purpose.

People also can find that in 1786, Clarkstown Town Clerk Ebenezer Wood recorded a bill of sale by a local resident for the sum of 160 pounds. The sale items included one chestnut mare, a black woman names Jade, a black youth named Harry, two steers, two heifers and a sorrel horse.

The digitizing of the records was made possible with a \$40,000 grant from the state archives grants administration unit. While more than 250 years worth of records have been digitized, vital records will not be available to view on the Internet because of privacy concerns. People seeking birth, death and marriage certificates will still have to go to Town Hall, but staff can print the desired certificate from the computer.

Thursday, April 17th, 1833, at a Court of Common Pleas held at the Courthouse at Clarkstown, in and for the County of Rockland: In the matter of the Petition of Lawrence Proudfoot for the establishment of a Ferry at Grassy Point. On reading and filing the Petition of Lawrence Proudfoot, setting forth that he is the owner, proprietor and occupant of the tract of land, dock and landing situate on the west bank of Hudson River, in the Town of Haverstraw, in the County of Rockland commonly called and known by the name of Grassy Point, and praying for a license to set up, keep and maintain a ferry across Hudson River, from Grassy Point aforesaid to some convenient point or place on the east side of said river, between the north part of that part of Ver Planks Point now owned by Phillip Ver Planck and the south bounds or line of the farm late of John Brotherson, deceased, in the Town of Cortland in the County of Westchester; and the said Lawrence Proudfoot having entered into such a recognizance as is by law required, and filed the same with the Clerk of this County. It is thereupon ordered and directed, and this Court, in pursuance of the power and authority given in and by the Act in such case made and provided, doth hereby authorize and license the said Lawrence Proudfoot to set up, keep and maintain a ferry across Hudson River, from Grassy Point aforesaid *etc., etc.* with the exclusive privilege of ferrying at Grassy Point aforesaid, for the period of three years, next succeeding the grant of this license. That the said Lawrence Proudfoot shall at all reasonable times during said term, between sunrise and sundown, keep in readiness, to transport passengers, horses, carriages, cattle, and goods and merchandise across said river, one or more boats, convenient and safe, for the transportation across said river, *etc.* with a proper and skillful man to manage and tend the same. That the said Lawrence Proudfoot be and is hereby authorized to exact and receive the following rates of ferriage, to wit: For a single passenger, twenty five cents: a single horse, fifty cents, a single horse and rider seventy five cents, each single waggon twenty five cents, double waggon thirty seven and a half cents, single waggon horse and driver seventy five cents, a double horse waggon and driver, one dollar, oxen and cows each twenty five cents, calves ten cents each, sheep each six and one fourth cents for any number less than ten, for ten sheep and over, each four cents: for hogs, ten cents each, all goods wares and merchandize [sic] at the rate of _____.

And the said Court doth also hereby direct and order that no person shall be permitted to transport for hire or pay, across the said river between the North side of Stony Point and as far South as the property in lands of the said Lawrence Proudfoot extends on the Hudson River, in the Town of Haverstraw and County of Rockland, to the opposite shore of said river, between the points herein before mentioned, and person or persons, horses, carriages, cattle, goods or merchandize, under penalty of ten dollars for each and every offence. [sic]

10 & 11 September: *Finding Your New Netherland Roots: A Two-Day Workshop on New Netherland Family History.* In celebration of the 400th anniversary of the arrival of Henry Hudson in New York, the NYG&B, in collaboration with the Holland Society, and the New York Public Library, offer a Dutch research program featuring several of the leading experts in Dutch studies. Sponsors include The Van Pelt Family Association, The Algonquin Hotel, and The Historic Hotels of America program.

In celebration of the 400th anniversary of Henry Hudson's arrival, this program will include presentations on the history of the Netherlands and its colony, as well as the persistence of Dutch culture in America, all designed to help you better understand the world in which your ancestors lived. The central focus of the program will be on resources and research methods to help you trace your roots through New York and New Jersey back to New Netherland and across the Atlantic, breaking through those brick walls that remain on your charts and expanding your knowledge of all your New Netherland ancestors."

Thursday, 10 September will be a full day of lectures regarding Dutch research, culture, and history in the South Court Auditorium of the New York Public Library. Friday, 11 September offers a day of assisted research at the NYPL's Milstein Division, and/or at the Holland Society Library.

In addition to the lectures and research, a number of festive social events will also be held. A gala banquet featuring Ms Peter G. Rose, the foremost authority on the food customs and diet of the colonial Dutch, will be held Thursday evening for an additional charge of \$75. Ms Rose's talk is entitled *Art in Food and Food in Art*.

A walking tour retracing the haunts of the early Dutch in what became New York will be held Saturday morning for an additional charge of \$20.00.

The two-day program is available to members of the NYG&B and members of the Holland Society for \$150. Non-members \$200. Registration for the Thursday lecture program only is \$90 members/ \$125 non-members.

Our Speakers:

Christopher Brooks began researching his paternal grandmother's Traphagen family in 1973. Utilizing a range of source material from American libraries, archives and his personal library, he has found that, with the maturing of the internet, much beneficial information relevant to New Netherland settlers is becoming available online to researchers through European archives. He lives in Kansas City, Missouri, where he works for a computer software company and is an avid researcher in New Netherland families and their European origins.

Firth Haring Fabend, a historian specializing in the Dutch in New York and New Jersey, is the author of the prize-winning books *A Dutch Family in the Middle Colonies, 1660-1800*, and *Zion on the Hudson: Dutch New York and New Jersey in the Age of Revivals*, both published by Rutgers University Press, and many shorter works. Her most recent book is *Land So Fair*, a historical novel and family saga set in New York and New Jersey in the eighteenth century with flashbacks to New Netherland.

Harry Macy Jr. edited *The NYG&B Record* from 1987 to 2006 and was also founding co-editor of *The NYG&B Newsletter*. He is a Fellow of The American Society of Genealogists, The Holland Society of New York, and The New York Genealogical and Biographical Society.

Peter G. Rose, Dutch food historian, is the author of several books on the subject of the influence of the Dutch on the American kitchen and lectures nationally and internationally on the subject.

Janny Venema is Associate Director of the New Netherland Project, Albany. Her many publications include *Deacons' Account Books of Albany's First Church, 1652-1674* (1998) and *Beverwijck. A Dutch Village on the American Frontier, 1652-1664* (2003, her Ph.D. dissertation from the Vrije Universiteit, Amsterdam). She is currently working on a biography of Kiliaen Van Rensselaer.
