



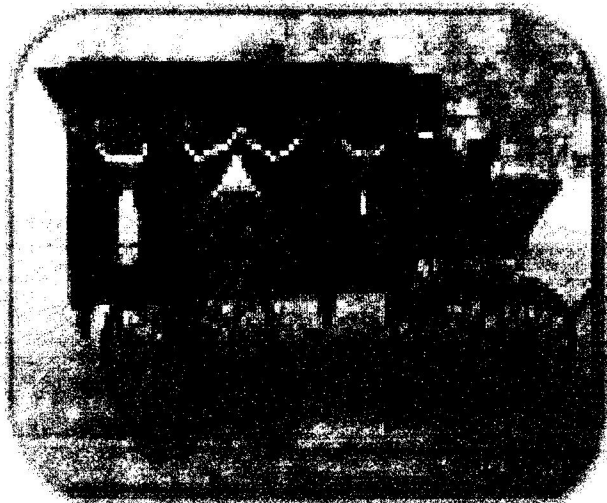

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Here are some of the projects that are currently underway by members of the Genealogical Society.

About two thirds of St Peters Cemetery in Haverstraw has been recorded. When done, it will have to be computerized and proofread. We are still working on the Orangetown, Haverstraw and Stony Point Cemeteries. We have received copies of several church records; we plan on using in upcoming news- letters.

The 1865 and 1905 censuses for Stony Point are in various stages of completion. Also, in progress, is the 1892 census for all of Rockland. This information will be put on the GSRC website with connections to the images of the actual censuses. This issue contains the Nyack Sewer Census that Jack Cullen completed for the Society.

As mentioned in previous newsletters, we have on-going projects such as the obituary books. Imagine how nice it would have been if you had been able to find a book of obituary when you started your search! Ancestor Charts are a great help in doing your family genealogy which could be shared with others. If you don't want your generation shown, start with an ancestor and work back from there.

Tom Riley, our new president has received some information on the orphanage trains. We are looking forward to hearing more from him on the trains.

Maryann Smith is working on the soldiers who served in the Civil War. She is using Loescher's listing and has added more information to the records from other sources. We hope to begin that series in our next Newsletter.

Please consider sending in something which will help preserve your family's history. You may have a bible that is the only documentation of a person's birth and/or death. It may be just the piece of information needed by someone completing their family genealogy. Please share.

It's wonderful to get a summary of the monthly meetings in the Newsletter. Makes you feel if you can't attend the meetings when you live 1,000 miles away that there's interesting things going on in New City.

Les....just read the latest news letter and am quite interested in the area. As you know Jacob Bailey and Mary Ann Garrison were my great grandparents. I looked at the picture on the front page for all of a few seconds and did a recall.

In 1942 my Dad (John Montanye, my Mom, Art (husband) and I were up in the cemetery area picnicking! The cherries were ripe so that was dessert. In looking at the headstones, my Dad said his grandparents and his great-grandparents were all buried in the same place - cemetery. There were no headstones but over near the stone wall there was the appearance of graves. Daddy said there had been field stones when he was younger and went to Jacob Bailey's funeral as a young lad. For some reason he thought Abby Bailey Montanye was buried there too but he didn't know why he thought so. Well, the war came along and things got separated so I never got a chance to ask more about the cemetery. Dad died just after Xmas in 1946. Does this confuse the issue? I have no proof....

Herbert Dutcher Shuart died September 6, 2010. He was born on May 29, 1929 in Mahwah, NJ to the late Theodore & Blanche (Dutcher) Shuart. Herb was a self-taught craftsman and builder, leaving behind a legacy of beautiful custom homes, and woodwork for many to enjoy. Herb is survived by his wife Jeannette (Jan), son, Don Shuart, Decatur, GA; three daughters: Pat Lowenhaupt, Palmetto, Judy Witt, Bradentown, and Debbie (David) Cerquozzi, Myakka City; two brothers; Arthur of Howes Cave, NY, Curtis (Regina) of Suffern, NY; six grandchildren: Lisa Greenwalt, Jamie Lowenhaupt, and Andy, Ashley, Joey and Joshua Cerquozzi; and four great grandchildren. He was deceased by his parents and five brothers; Wesley, Stanley, Ted, Clyde and Howard.

Nyack Sewer Census 1893

The Village of Nyack, in 1893, ordered that a survey to be conducted for the purpose for installing sewers. An enumerator was selected, and he conducted a block-by-block census of property owners and their stated number of residents. His description of each block is included as an appendix.

This census was indexed by John D. Cullen in the spring of 2004. Everything the enumerator wrote was faithfully transcribed; even spellings felt to be incorrect. There were too many of these to be noted "sic" individually. Other idiosyncrasies of the enumerator were noted but ignored.

The summary by the enumerator is included as are subsequent population notes. The final process was to sort entries by surname for ease of use. This resulted in the possibility of the same person appearing on multiple lines as owner of several properties.

Genealogical Research at Cornell

The purpose of this guide is to aid genealogists in using the resources and services of Cornell University Library effectively. The library's primary mission is to support the academic research needs of the Cornell community. There is no special "genealogical collection" and no staff genealogist, so the burden is on the researcher to organize and carry out his or her research. With proper preparation, genealogists will find much useful material in the library and a staff ready to help with specific questions.

There are twenty libraries at Cornell. Almost all the genealogical material is held in the Olin/Kroch building. Visiting researchers should become familiar with library procedures and policies. The following handouts are available at the desk; Cornell University Library Guide, Library Catalog Quickguide, and Olin Library Stack Guide.

Cornell Library Online Catalog

The online catalog is the most important resource for gaining access to the collection. The online catalog contains everything the library has acquired. It is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. The online catalog is available to the general public on the World Wide Web at <http://catalog.library.cornell.edu/>. For help please contact a local library with internet access.

In addition to the our local online catalog, CUL provides access to a national online "catalog"—the **OCLC Worldcat** database and Research Libraries Group's **RLIN Eureka**. These databases can be accessed within the library by visiting researchers; however, remote access (from outside the library) is available only to the students, staff and faculty of Cornell. Many public and academic libraries provide access to Worldcat.

Worldcat has several thousand member libraries and around 80 million records. Many archival records have been entered.

Worldcat can be found through the **Find Databases** link on the **Library Gateway**. Visiting researchers can access these databases through library workstations on-site.

There is also a free version of Wildcat available at <http://www.worldcat.org>. An interesting feature of this version is that it lists all the libraries that might have a specific item starting with the library closest to you. It even shows how many miles between your location and that library.

Library of Latter-Day Saints

Library of Latter-Day Saints is another resource that should not be overlooked. Founded in 1894 to gather genealogical records and assist members of the Church of Jesus Christ Latter-day Saints with their family history and genealogical research, it is open to the general public at no charge. To view its online catalog, go to <http://www.familysearch.org/>, and select the Library tab, then select the Family History Library Catalog option.

Steele Memorial Library Genealogy Room:

The Steele Memorial Library is one of the few public libraries in the State of New York to maintain a Genealogical Collection. This special collection is located on the second floor of the library and offers a wide range of genealogical resources. The staff is trained to assist you, and although they do not perform individualized research, they will direct you to locating desired materials or information.
