WOODLAWN CEMETERY

By Susan Olsen, Historian and Director of Historical Services Friends of Woodlawn Cemetery Location: Webster Avenue & East 233rd Street. Bronx. NY

Woodlawn was established at the peak of the Civil War in 1863 on a 400-acre landscape of rolling hills, majestic mausoleums and memorials, flowering shrubbery and spectacular trees. It is one of the most historic and notable cemeteries in the world, a National Treasure!

Re-interments were made from Dyckman-Nagle Burying Ground, Manhattan; West Farms Dutch Reformed Church Cemetery; Bensonia (Morrisania) Cemetery, and Rutgers Street Church Graveyard.

The Friends sponsor many activities throughout the year as part of funding to preserve the historic past, defining the present, and securing the future of Woodlawn.

The Friends have many volunteers that work on genealogy by preserving records of the monuments, mausoleums. There are 310,000 people buried at Woodlawn, the records are alphabetically kept by legal name at death, exact death date. There are six points of cross referencing the records if a body is moved out of the cemetery to another location. They also have records of 16 early cemeteries and maps. Their records span from 1863 to 2011, the 150th anniversary is approaching. The Friends are in the process of putting the records in an online database and putting biographies of loved ones on the Find-A-Grave website.

Among the well-known celebrities buried at Woodlawn are: Admiral Farragut, 1870; Ulysses S. Grant; Herman Melville, 1891; Elizabeth Stanton; Jay Gould – the first mausoleum was designed by his friends. Collis P. Huntington; the Taylor mausoleum, 1902, was designed by McKim Mead & White. Fiorello LaGuardia, Robert Moses, Miles Davis, Clarence Day, Geraldine Fitzgerald, Irving Berlin, George M. Cohen, Duke Ellington, and Bat Masterson.

Historical note:

The Danube Swabians: descendants of German colonists who settled during the 18th century around the Danube River and its tributaries, in an area widely known as the Pannonian Lowland. They came from the overpopulated westernmost part of the Holy Roman Empire of the German Nation, and also from Austria, Bavaria and Bohemia. They traveled by barges hundreds of miles down the Danube River to their new homesteads in the frontier land of the southeastern part of the Empire, the Kingdom of Hungary

Between 1890 and 1930, 350,000 came to America, where they became known as "German-Hungarians." The fall of the Austro-Hungarian Empire at the end of WW I brought about drastic change in the area – the land was divided up among Hungary, Yugoslavia and Romania. With WW II, the Swabians were all but eradicated. Those that survived the Communist ordeal migrated and settled in Germany and Austria, Australia, South America and Canada.
